NEXT ONLINE LENTEN SERIES PRESENTATION: MARCH 10, 6:30 PM on ZOOM

St. Stephen's, along with other churches of the Episcopal Diocese of West Texas, has put together a new Lenten Series, "Nevertheless, the Kingdom Has Come Near to You." The series is intended to be an exploration of how God has been moving and blessing us through the last year. It is open to all and will be held 100% online. It is structured with weekly presentations containing a teaching topic, specific scripture, and virtual breakout sessions for small group discussions followed by the larger group Q&A.
