Vestry Meeting Report – 29 November 2021

The Vestry met on Monday 29 November 2021. The Treasurer's Report (Roy Buckley) showed cumulative expenses are ~ \$ 3,556 under cumulative income. However, October, pledge receipts were only \$ 27,385, more than \$ 6,000 below budget. Father Kevin sent all parishioners an EMAIL urging them to check up on their pledge balance. So if you are behind, please catch up!

The stewardship campaign was completed in October. There are still some of you we have not heard from. If you are one of these, please return your pledge ASAP. We are working on the 2022 budget and we need your pledges to prepare an accurate budget.

St. Stephens is forming a chapter of the Order of St. Naucratus. This order promotes ethical hunting and fishing, and members contribute a portion of their game to the needy. A freezer will be acquired and game received will go to Amigos de Jesus. More on this shortly.
